

Lamar County Commissioners Special Called Meeting  
August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013  
6:30 P.M.

The Lamar County Board of Commissioners held a Special Called Meeting on Wednesday August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. Present for the meeting were Chairman Jay Matthews, Vice-Chairman Bennie Horton, Commissioner Charles Glass, Commissioner Van Baker, Commissioner Nancy Thrash, County Administrator Robert Zellner and Financial Analyst Carlette Davidson.

Commissioner Thrash made a motion to approve Resolution Number 2013-04 the Board of Commissioners Ad Valorem Tax Levy which sets the millage rate at 10.481. Commissioner Baker seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

Commissioner Horton made a motion to approve Resolution Number 2013-05 setting the millage at 12.571 with a roll back of 2.09 mill roll back for the local option sales tax. Commissioner Glass seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

Commissioner Glass made a motion to approve Resolution Number 2013-06 the Board of Education's Ad Valorem Tax Levy which sets the millage rate at 16.632 based on the 2013 net tax digest of \$487,461,273.00 dollars. Commissioner Thrash seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

There being no further business to discuss Commissioner Glass made a motion for the meeting to adjourn at 6:42 p.m. Commissioner Horton seconded the motion. The motion passed by 4-0.
